His endorsement allowed my career to vault pass science into post-science. Paul Feyerabend with the help of Benson Mates sponsored me for eight years at the Dept. of Philosophy, after I showed him a half-page note "The Foundation of Knowledge Is Faith, Not Reason." Milton Friedman collaborated with me in lecturing to the Chinese students and scholars on "The Chinese Economic Reform" disrupted by the June fourth 1989 Ten An Men Student rebellion. William Kinnard, James Mason, Tom and Mary Dum, and I led all the authorities in real estate appraisal to solve the S&L Crisis. William Seidman called my attention to FIRREA. K. T. Li and Friedman are the chief architects of the Chinese economic reform. Alan Greenspan rejected then accepted my prediction of S&L Crisis. Richard Stallman lives in our dormitory. Ta-You Wu, T. L. Kunii, and C. V. Ramamoorthy and I are the founders of Post-Science Institute. George Hsieh provided the university to approach NSF. Gerard Debreu and Kenneth Arrow defined the problem of value for my solution of value. Chien Yi Lee invented Universal Computer Source Code. Ben S. Bernanke rejected and then accepted my prediction of the Subprime Woe and the prime witness of my prediction. Neel Kashkari delivered my message in my US Treasury comments to the Congress to "lower the interest rate as much and as rapidly as possible." Rustin Roy was the fourth person after Ching, Wu, and Kunii to see jumpulse as the solution of touch.
